Members of the First Wimmerton Community:

Please be advised that our Community has been targeted by vandals and thieves in recent months and your First Wimmerton Community Association Board of Directors would like to take this opportunity to heighten your awareness and make you more diligent. Items we would like you to consider:

- If you must have your car parked outside, PLEASE REMEMBER TO KEEP THE DOORS LOCKED....ESPECIALLY AT NIGHT.
- Remember to check garage doors and side access doors that they are closed and locked when you are not at home, and during nighttime hours.
- Keep windows clear of shrubbery
- Keep your front and back porch lights on
- Consider installing motion lights

Keep an eye out for suspicious activity, especially at night. There have been reports of suspicious cars driving through Wimmerton after mid-night and during the early morning hours at night.

Be aware and proactive...If you see suspicious activity that appears to be Vandalism or thievery, please call *911* and report it to the State Police.

Due to this recent activity, and with interest expressed by some residents, we are looking into establishing a Neighborhood Watch program in the community. We would like to know if you are interested and whether or not you want us to pursue becoming a Neighborhood Watch community.
